Dr. Cupo received a Bachelor's Degree in Biomedical Engineering from the University of Southern California in 1987 and her Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Southern California in 1992. She completed a Residency in Pharmacy Practice at LAC+USC Medical Center in 1993. Dr. Cupo joined the faculty at USC in late 1993. As a member of the clinical faculty, Dr. Cupo is responsible for teaching clerkships in acute care medicine, providing didactic lectures in the microbiology and antimicrobial agents courses and for precepting residents on their pulmonary critical care rotation. Dr. Cupo's professional affiliations include ASHP, CSHP (Southern California Chapter), ACCP (Southern California Chapter), and AACP.
